

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF ISYCOED COMMUNITY
COUNCIL HELD AT ISYCOED VILLAGE
HALL ON 15th October, 2013.**

Members present.

Councillors: D Bould, P Ellis, S Ellis, KH Manning, M Morris, P Jones, and P Williams.

Apologies: Mrs L Dawes .

PCSO Luke Dobby had sent his apologies.

PCSO's Lisa Davies and Phil Peters attended in his place and went through the latest crime statistics for the area and answered Members questions.

The Chairman asked for a copy of the statistics to be sent to the Clerk so that he could circulate them to Members.

A PCSO would be located on the Industrial Estate (to be based in Redwither Towers) and the Police were waiting for a room to be allocated and the IT to be set up.

The Police had arranged for a bonfire event at Abenbury Community Centre on 3rd November. Councillor Morris informed the Police that the Residents Association had arranged an event on 31st October at the same venue.

The Chairman thanked PCSO's for their attendance and they left the Meeting.

236. WEBSITE.

Richard Rayworth attended the Meeting.

He distributed a note to Members and went through it in detail.

The Website would include the Council Minutes; News & Events; Planning Applications; contact details; pictures, etc .+possible logo

Members asked if it could be linked to the N Wales Police Website-**agreed** that Mr Rayworth would look into this.

The School, Church, NFU, and Isycoed Issue would all be able to include items under the News & Events part of the website. The Council would be able to advertise the Village Hall.

Members **agreed** that the Council would accept the quote from Mr Rayworth to set up and run the site.

Members also **agreed** to approach the local primary school to ask the pupils to submit a logo for the website-prize of £25 for best entry.

The Chairman thanked Mr Rayworth for his attendance and he left the Meeting.

237. MINUTES.

Members **resolved** that the minutes of the Meeting held on 18th September, 2013 be confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

238. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE PREVIOUS MEETING.

Lighting column-the Clerk updated Members. He was awaiting an 'offer' for the invoice to be reduced to 50% of the cost. Members **agreed** to pay the invoice upon receipt of this offer. Members also **agreed** to look at removal of the column if, in the future, it was damaged again and the damage could not be attributed to a particular vehicle.

Section 78 Appeal re P/2012/0783-Land South of Barn Cottage-appeal decision awaited.

Town & Community Council Forum-3rd October-feedback given.

Village Hall Grant-the Chairman confirmed that the quote did not include VAT. Work was due to start in the next couple of weeks. Mr White (the electrician) had been asked to replace the lights in the entrance hall prior to the start of the decorating.

Two properties near the Redwither Pub-update given. Members asked the Clerk to enquire whether the second property had approval for 'change of use'- original use was for caravan sales-now being used for scrapping vehicles.

239. TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The following planning application was considered at the Meeting:

P/2013/0671-Outline Planning Application for the construction of a Prison (maximum floorspace of 76,370 sqm. gross external area.) within a secure perimeter fence together with access, parking, visitor/support building, energy centre, landscaping, construction compound and associated engineering works- Former Firestone Factory Site, Bridge Road, Wrexham Industrial Estate, Wrexham.

-the Council **agreed** to ask for improvement to the road junction by the Redwither Pub-possibly a roundabout.

-Members also **agreed** for landscaping on Bridgeway East including embankments with trees. It was also **agreed** that these works should be carried out prior to the construction work on the actual Prison. .
